Description of Incident:

On 2/28/13 at 12:47 am, the Santa Cruz Sheriff's Office was patrolling the City of Santa Cruz, when they were dispatched to a commercial burglary at O'Neil's Surf Shop, 110 Cooper St.

Two suspects, Harley Dean, age 19 and Daniel Hark, age 25 smashed the front window of O'Neil's Surf Shop, stole five skate boards and fled the scene. Witnesses called 911 and gave descriptions of Dean and Hark to the dispatchers and notified which way they fled. Minutes later deputies found Dean and Hark hiding behind cars in the Civic Auditorium parking lot and arrested both suspects.

Deputies located the stolen skateboards with security tags in a flower bed near the O'Neil's Surf Shop. They also collected surveillance video which caught the Harley and Hark committing the commercial burglary.
