## Convicted Felon Arrested with Guns

On 2/1/18 at about 5PM, deputies from the Santa Cruz County Special Investigations Unit found Jackson Dapont in a motel room in the 500 block of Riverside Avenue in the City of Santa Cruz. Dapont had two warrants for his arrest and was on active probation. Jackson was arrested for the warrants and the motel room was searched.

During the course of the investigation, deputies detained Terry Spann and another woman inside the motel room. Deputies found a .22 caliber bolt action rifle with a scope, a .308 caliber AR10 semi-automatic rifle, and a machine to manufacture fraudulent credit cards. The AR10 Rifle had a scope, laser sight, and a bipod attached to the weapon.

Spann was arrested for 29800 (A) (1) PC Felon in Possession of a Firearm, 30305 (a) PC Felon in Possession of Ammunition, and 32310 PC Possession of a Large Capacity Magazine. Spann's bail was

set at \$25,000 dollars.

Dapont, was arrested for two warrants, 484 i (c) PC Possession of Credit Card Manufacturing Equipment, and 3454 PC Probation Hold. Dapont is being held without bail until his next court appearance.

Sheriff Jim Hart said, "Keeping our community safe from gun violence is one of our top priorities. This case involved some great police work and we removed two dangerous firearms from the hands of known criminals. I am very thankful that we were able to seize these firearms before any damage was done."
