Scenario synopsis:

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Scenario 1:

You are assigned as the Flex Officer. As one of your tasks you are assigned to pick your partner up and an inmate up from Dominican Hospital. In route to Dominican, you are involved in an accident.

- Officer needs to demonstrate ability to contact Netcom, CHP, or appropriate personnel
- Officer needs to demonstrate understanding of where to find the emergency bag and how to use it
- Officer needs to demonstrate ability/knowledge of what needs to be done during and after the accident

Scenario 2:

You are assigned as the Booking Officer. You are assigned to transport 4 inmates from the Main Jail to Rountree Jail Facility.

- Officer needs to demonstrate how to properly get inmates prepared to leave the Main Jail Facility, i.e getting inmates appropriately dressed and chained.
- Officer needs to demonstrate ability and knowledge when searching the transport vehicle.
- Officer needs to demonstrate ability to complete the Transport Plan and know where to find the Transport Plan.
- Officer needs to demonstrate ability to contact Netcom
- Officer needs to demonstrate ability to notify Control/ Rountree of transport along with how many inmates being transported.
- Officer needs to demonstrate ability to check the transport vehicle after completing the transport.
